A vote will take place on the by-law change that is listed below. Please note that the change is the red print, and a new addition to the change has been requested by Mr. Crone in teal ink.

In accordance with the current by-laws, the proposed change was read at the meeting on Jan. 4, 2012 and the vote on this change will occur at the general meeting on Feb. 8, 2012 at the Junior High. For the proposed change to be enacted, it must pass with a two-thirds majority of the vote of the BPO members in good standing that are in attendance at the meeting when the vote is being held. So, those of you that purchased a yellow (yellow) membership card at the beginning of the year and have a child that is still an active band member, you are able to vote on this by-law change.

5. Extra money earned through fundraising by a student for a trip, may be applied to trip expenses for a non-Band-member sibling or a parent or guardian who is going on the trip, once the Band member's trip expense is met.

All extra fundraising monies in freshmen's, sophomores' and juniors' Student Fund accounts remaining after a trip will remain in the student's account to be used as funding for future trips until the student is no longer a member of the marching band as determined by the Band Director, at which time it will transfer to the account of a current Band member sibling or a sibling coming into the ninth grade, or will otherwise be transferred into the General Fund or to the Friends-of-the-Band Fund at the discretion of the Band Director. (see Article VII, Section 5) This change in student accounting will take effect as of Feb. 8, 2012

Extra fundraising monies remaining in seniors' accounts after a major trip will be transferred to the Friends-of-the-Band Fund. After a senior trip, extra fundraising monies in senior's accounts may be transferred to the account of a current Band Member sibling or a sibling coming into the ninth grade, or will otherwise be transferred into the Friends-of-the-Band Fund. (see Article VII, Section 5). If a Band Member, for any reason, does not attend the scheduled trip and has fundraised monies in their account, the Band Member forfeits such funds to the General Fund or Friends of the Band Fund. This may be waived by the Band Director in the case of an emergency. An emergency can be defined, but is not excluded to, an illness or death in the family or other situation that occurs at a time that does not permit the Band Member to attend. General disinterest in the trip or any school disciplinary actions do not constitute an emergency

Please remember to come to the General Meeting on Wed., Feb.8 at the Jr. High Café to vote on the proposed by law change. Also, mark your calendars for the mandatory trip meeting on Wed., March 7 in the High School Auditorium. A parent or guardian for each band member attending the trip must be present at this meeting.

Fund Raising Reminders



All fund raisers are prepaid. Orders will not be placed unless payment accompanies the order form. All orders must be placed in a sealed envelope with the student's name, the name of the fund raiser, and the amount of the payment printed on the front of the envelope.

All checks must be made out to **WHHS BPO**. Each check must have the name of the student receiving credit on the *memo line*. Please note: Any check which is returned Non Sufficient Funds will be charged up to \$24.00 in bank handling fees which will be deducted from the student's account along with the total amount of the check. Credit will not be given for the fund raiser until the check is made good. Any outstanding money owed to the band will become a senior obligation for graduation. All orders must be picked up on the date specified in the fundraising letter. We do not have facilities to hold orders. If paying by cash, PLEASE try to condense the money to the smallest amount possible. For example, try not to place 57 one dollar bills with your order.

Orders MUST be received by the due date. The due dates are set by the fundraising companies. All orders MUST be picked up on the date specified in the fundraising letter. We do not have facilities to hold orders. All fundraising materials will be handed out at marching band practices. Additional materials will be left in Mr. Crone's office for students not present at the time of distribution. When possible, information will also be included in the newsletter and shared at the Band Parents meetings. When marching band is no longer in session, fundraisers will also be available in the junior highs as well as the high school. Orders not completed correctly will be returned, so if you have a question, please ask. Each fundraiser will have the name of a contact person who is happy to help you.
