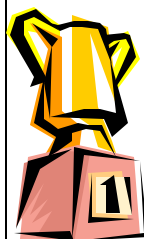

## WOODLAND HILLS WINTERGUARD WINS FIRST PLACE!



The BPO congratulates the WHHS Senior Winterguard for winning first place at the 2004 Three Rivers Winter Ensemble Association (TRWEA) Championship Competition in the Scholastic Regional A Colorguard classification on April 3rd at Norwin

High School!

Lead by Captains Sara Ford, Dorothy Garbin and Heather Hunt, and directed by Vicky Moran and Stacey Gething, the Senior Winterguard performed their competition routine, which incorporated combinations of dance, flag, rifle and saber skills to the song "1000 Beautiful Things" by Annie Lennox.

The WHHS Senior Winterguard placed 1st out of four groups in their classification, with a total score of 84.0, which moves them up to Scholastic A.

Judges for the Colorguard Competition included Michael Yoho, who judged Individual Analysis-Equipment; Lee Kumer, who judged Individual Analysis-Movement; Carl Miller, who judged Ensemble Analysis; and Dave Campbell and John Howell, who judged General Effect.

Overall, the Championship Competition included 52 judged units in the categories of baton, dance, colorguard, and percussion, both independent and scholastic.

## VOLUNTEERS ARE NEEDED FOR THE 2004 PITTSBURGH THREE RIVERS REGATTA FROM JULY 2ND THRU 5TH!

The WHHS BPO is sponsoring a booth at this year's Pittsburgh Three Rivers Regatta. We are looking for volunteers to help sell water as well as beads and blinky lights. We need people to work 5 hour shifts from July 2nd thru July 5th with a minimum of 5 people per shift. You may work more than one shift. This is open to both parents and students. Regatta hours are 10:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. One-half of all profits made will be shared among all workers based on the hours worked (Subject to change).

For example:

Over the four day event, there are a total of 56 hours the Regatta will be open which equates to a total of 12 shifts. If we have 5 volunteers that work during each shift, that equals to a total of 60 volunteer shifts (5 volunteers \* 12 shifts). If the band parents make a profit of \$24,000 over the Regatta, \$12,000 will be split based on the number of shifts you work. If there are a total of 60 volunteer shifts and you worked 1 shift, your child's account will receive \$200 ( $\$12,000/60*1$ ). If, however, you worked two shifts and the total of volunteer shifts remained at 60, your child's account will receive \$400 ( $\$12,000/60*2$ ). If there were 64 volunteer shifts worked and you worked one shift, your child's account will receive \$187.50 ( $\$12,000/64*1$ ). The more shifts you work, the more money goes into your child's account. Working only 5 hours has the potential of earning roughly one-third of your child's trip if your child will be a senior next year or one-fifth of your child's trip for the 2005-2006 band season. Please keep in mind that the dollar amounts and volunteer shifts worked are for illustrative purposes only and is in no way a guarantee of the amount to be earned to your child's account. 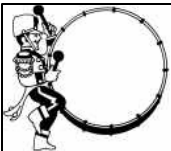

## FUND RAISING REMINDERS

All fund raisers are prepaid. Orders will not be placed unless payment accompanies the order form. All orders must be placed in a sealed envelope with the student's name, the name of the fund raiser, and the amount of the payment printed on the front of the envelope.

All checks must be made out to WHHS BPO. Each check must have the name of the student receiving credit on the memo line. Please note: Any check which is returned Non Sufficient Funds will be charged a \$6.00 return check fee which will be deducted from the student's account along with the total amount of the check. Credit will not be given for the fund raiser until the check is made good. Any outstanding money owed to the band will become a senior obligation for graduation.

All orders must be picked up on the date specified in the fundraising letter. We do not have facilities to hold orders.
