

5. Extra money earned through fundraising by a student for a trip, may be applied to trip expenses for a non-Band-member sibling or a parent or guardian who is going on the trip, once the Band member's trip expense is met. All extra fundraising monies in freshmen's, sophomores' and juniors' Student Fund accounts remaining after a trip will remain in the student's account to be used as funding for future trips until the student is no longer a member of the marching band as determined by the Band Director, at which time it will transfer to the account of a current Band member sibling or a sibling coming into the ninth grade, or will otherwise be transferred into the General Fund or to the Friends-of-the-Band Fund at the discretion of the Band Director. (see Article VII, Section 5). This change in student accounting will take effect as of Feb. 8, 2012. Extra fundraising monies remaining in seniors' accounts after a major trip will be transferred to the Friends-of-the-Band Fund. After a senior trip, extra fundraising monies in senior's accounts may be transferred to the account of a current Band Member sibling or a sibling coming into the ninth grade, or will otherwise be transferred into the Friends-of-the-Band Fund. (see Article VII, Section 5). If a Band Member, for any reason, does not attend the scheduled trip and has fundraised monies in their account, the Band Member forfeits such funds to the General Fund or Friends of the Band Fund. This may be waived by the Band Director in the case of an emergency. An emergency can be defined, but is not excluded to, an illness or death in the family or other situation that occurs at a time that does not permit the Band Member to attend. General disinterest in the trip or any school disciplinary actions do not constitute an emergency
